

GPS

All racers are required to have the routes downloaded in their GPS devices or phones. Racers are required to make sure that they are using the correct stage each day and have a back-up device in case of low battery or malfunction. The routes will only be marked in the places where the organization sees it necessary. All racers are required to have a device either mounted on their handlebars or in their wrist (not in their backpacks).

It is obligatory to use a GPS. The GPS helps us minimize the chances that racers can get lost and helps us to keep the race route clean.

Race start and stages

All racers need to be ready 30 minutes before the start time of each stage. All racers must be lined up at the start line 10 minutes before the start time in order to receive instructions from the organization.



Stage One will start at the Hotel La Joya in Pachuca with a controlled start of about 9km as the caravan crosses the city of Pachuca. The racers will need to stay together during the controlled start until the guide car indicates otherwise.

Transportation

The race begins in Pachuca and finishes in the town of Huasca (about 30 minutes from Pachuca). The race will move one suitcase or bag per racer from Pachuca to Huasca. At the end of the race, transportation will be provided to take racers back to the Hotel la Joya in Pachuca.

Award Ceremony and Transportation back to Pachuca

The award ceremony is scheduled to take place at 3:00pm in Huasca at the finish line.

Rides back to Pachuca will start at 4:00pm.

Additional Information:

We would like to remind all participants that it is prohibited to receive support from personal staff at any time during the race with one exception. Personal staff may help participants only at designated checkpoints.

We highly recommend that all racers carry \$100 or \$200 pesos in cash with them at all times in case of an emergency. There are many small stores along the way where participants can by extra food, if needed.



With a few exceptions, most of the racecourse gets cell phone reception. We recommend that participants always check that they have a full battery at the beginning of each stage.

The race director will have the final word on decisions that need to be taken during the days of the race. Each participant must be prepared to follow these decisions. If any changes to the route need to be made, the director will make an announcement during the instructions given in the 10 minutes before the start of each stage.
